RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF THOUSAND OAKS RECITING THE FACT
OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD
ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024, DECLARING THE
RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS
PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Thousand Oaks, California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in the time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; election officers were appointed and in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in the time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for holding of elections in General Law cities; and

WHEREAS, the Ventura County Elections Division canvassed the election returns and has certified the results to this City Council. The results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A."

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Thousand Oaks does resolve as follows:

Section 1. For District 4:

The whole number of ballots cast at vote centers was 1,683.

The whole number of vote-by-mail ballots cast was 11,304.

The total number of ballots cast was 12,987.

For District 5:

The whole number of ballots cast at vote centers was 1,615.

The whole number of vote-by-mail ballots cast was 9,228.

The total number of ballots cast was 10,843.

Section 2. The names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council were as follows:

District 4:

Al Adam and Jeff Schwarz

District 5:

Connie "Tie" Gutierrez, Brent Allen Hagel, Kevin McNamee, and Dan Twedt

Section 3. The number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in each City District for each candidate named above are listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

Section 4. The City Council declares and determines that Al Adam was elected as Member of the City Council, District 4, for the full term of four years.

The City Council declares and determines that Connie "Tie" Gutierrez was elected as Member of the City Council, District 5, for the full term of four years.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of ballots cast in the City by District; (2) The names of the persons voted for by District; (3) For what office each person was voted for by District; (4) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person by District; and (5) The total number of votes given to each person by District.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and

shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the City Clerk Department. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

Section 7. The City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
