

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THOUSAND OAKS CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2024, FOR THE ELECTION OF TWO COUNCILMEMBERS FOR FOUR-YEAR TERMS REPRESENTING DISTRICTS 4 AND 5 AS REQUIRED BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws relating to General Law Cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election shall be held on November 5, 2024, for the election of two (2) Members of the City Council representing Districts 4 and 5 for a term of four years.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Thousand Oaks resolves as follows that:

Section 1. Pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Thousand Oaks, California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing two (2) Members of the City Council representing Districts 4 and 5 for the full term of four years.

Section 2. Ballots to be used at the election shall be in a form and content as required by law.

Section 3. City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to coordinate with the Ventura County Clerk to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

Section 4. Vote centers for the election shall be open in the County of Ventura as required by California Elections Code § 3017 (California Voter's Choice Act), including opening at seven o'clock a.m. the day of the election and remaining open continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day when vote centers shall be closed, pursuant to California Elections Code § 10242, except as provided in California Elections Code §§ 14212 and 14401.

Section 5. In all particulars not recited in this Resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding Municipal Elections.

Section 6. Notice of time and place of holding the election is given and City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to give further or additional notice of election, in time, form, and manner as required by law.

Section 7. In the event of a tie vote as certified by the Ventura County Clerk, the City Council authorizes the Ventura County Clerk to utilize criteria set forth in Elections Code § 15651(a) and resolve the tie vote by lot.

Section 8. City Council authorizes the City Clerk to administer said election and all reasonable and actual election expenses shall be paid by the City upon presentation of a properly submitted bill by the County of Ventura.

Section 9. City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
