**A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF THOUSAND OAKS FINDING THAT
THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 AND 2026-2027 CITY
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM IS
CONSISTENT WITH THE THOUSAND OAKS 2045
GENERAL PLAN**

WHEREAS, Section 65103(c) of the California Government Code requires the Planning Commission to review the proposed Capital Improvement Program (CIP) and report to the City Council as to its consistency with the City's General Plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 65401 of the California Government Code requires the Planning Commission to make a determination whether the CIP is in conformance with the adopted General Plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 65402 of the California Government Code requires the Planning Commission to make a determination whether real property acquisition or disposition, street vacation or abandonment, public building or structure construction is in conformance with the adopted General Plan as to location, purpose and extent; and

WHEREAS, the CIP for Fiscal Years 2025-26 and 2026-27 / Thousand Oaks 2045 General Plan consistency determination report is not a "project" subject to review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) because it can be seen with certainty, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15378(b)(4), that there is no possibility that a determination of General Plan consistency report may have a significant impact on the environment as the proposed CIP for Fiscal Years 2025-26 and 2026-27 is a government funding document that does not commit to any specific project that could cause significant physical impact on the environment; and

WHEREAS, as required by CEQA, environmental review will be conducted prior to construction of the individual projects identified within CIP for Fiscal Years 2025-26 and 2026-27. Any required environmental documents will be prepared pursuant to CEQA as part of project permit processing or at any other point in time as required by CEQA; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission's "Consistency Determination of the City of Thousand Oaks Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2025-26 and 2026-27 with the Thousand Oaks 2045 General Plan" staff report dated April 7, 2025, identifies proposed projects and consistency with General Plan goals and policies; and

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2025, the Planning Commission reviewed the City's proposed CIP for Fiscal Years 2025-2026 and 2026-2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Planning Commission hereby finds that the projects presented in the CIP for Fiscal Years 2025-2026 and 2026-2027 are consistent with the Thousand Oaks 2045 General Plan.
