A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF THOUSAND OAKS TERMINATING THE
PROCLAMATION OF THE LOCAL EMERGENCY
DECLARED IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19
PANDEMIC AND RESCINDING EXECUTIVE
ORDER NO. 2020-01 AND RESOLUTION NO.
2021-055

WHEREAS, a local emergency remains in effect in the City of Thousand Oaks in accordance with the proclamation thereof by the Director of Emergency Services on March 12, 2020, which was ratified by the City Council of the City of Thousand Oaks per Resolution No. 2020-10 on the 17th day of March, 2020, as a result of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property caused by the COVID-19 pandemic though the City of Thousand Oaks; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 2020-01 was issued on March 19, 2020, suspending restrictions on deliveries to Food Establishments for the duration of the declared emergency; and

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2021, the City Council passed Resolution No. 2021-055 pertaining to a temporary waiver of certain Municipal Code provisions to allow flexibility for businesses to provide outdoor dining; and

WHEREAS, the situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril presented by the spread of COVID-19 is now deemed to be within the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of and within the City of Thousand Oaks.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Thousand Oaks does hereby resolve as follows:

1. The Proclamation of Local Emergency ratified by City Council by Resolution No. 2020-10 is hereby terminated.
2. Executive Order No. 2020-01 is hereby terminated in its entirety.
3. Resolution No. 2021-055 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

4. The content of this Resolution shall be given widespread publicity and notice as is reasonable and feasible under these circumstances.
